




To ensure that you have the best experience as a distinguished student at our university, we have dedicated the past two years to preparing our graduates to be the most qualified candidates in the job market by:



Admission Requirements

- You must be a high school graduate of the study tracks system in one of the following: general studies, computer science and engineering, or health and life sciences, or a graduate of international schools (natural sciences) in the current or the two previous years. This applies to all admission tracks.
- Achieve a minimum score of 65 on the STEP test or its equivalent in other tests (IELTS 4.5, TOEFL iBT 45, or Duolingo 80). This applies to all admission tracks, except for SAT and Olympiad.



We recommend taking the English test early in the first semester, as you can retake it multiple times to achieve the required score. Remember: a qualifying score is mandatory for admission; applications without it aren't accepted.

- A brief introduction about yourself that should explain your academic goals and how you will contribute to positive change in your community and the world during your journey at the university.
- An official recommendation letter from your school administrator in either Arabic or English.

Choose the ideal path to join KFUPM from a variety of admission tracks!



Primary Admission Track (Formerly Early)

This is the primary track for university admission, ensuring a competitive opportunity to secure a seat; the following tests each contribute equally to the overall score: 50% General Aptitude Test (Qudrat) and 50% KFUPM Achievement Test.

What is the KFUPM Achievement Test?

This test has been developed in collaboration with the National Center for Assessment (Qiyas). It is designed to assess the academic performance of students in scientific subjects for both tenth and eleventh grades. It is similar to the General Achievement Test (Tahsili) in terms of its format and content. It covers the following areas:

- The KFUPM Achievement Test is mandatory only for the Primary Admission Track and is not required for the other tracks.
- The test will take place twice: November 19th and December 23rd, 2025.
- Students must have achieved 85 or higher on the General Aptitude Test (Qudrat). • Registration for the Achievement Test is available on the Qiyas website for both
- Saudi and non-Saudi applicants.

Olympiad Track

If you win one of the International Science Olympiads recognized by the university, you will receive unconditional admission without needing the Aptitude or Achievement Tests.

SAT Track

If you score a minimum of 1350 on the SAT exam, you have a competitive opportunity to secure admission to limited seats without taking the Aptitude or Achievement tests. Please note that a score of 1350 only qualifies you to apply and does not guarantee admission, as selection is competitive and also depends on passing the mathematics test.



Requirements for this track:

- Successfully pass the university's mathematics test. A personal interview may be conducted for candidates.
- **Important!** The SAT track application opens only once a year during the admission period.

Secondary Admission Track (Vacancies) This track is designated for filling the limited remaining vacancies in undergraduate programs in case of

withdrawals from other tracks. Therefore, it is not recommended as the primary application choice, as seats are very limited. Admission is competitive and based on the following percentages: 50% for the General Aptitude Test (Qudrat), 40% for the General Achievement Test (Tahsili), and 10% for high school performance. The weighted average score will be calculated after the results of the second General Achievement Test are received.

You may choose your admissions track directly on the website and then complete the corresponding form directly on there. Important dates for admissions will be posted on the official admissions website.




Selecting a major

Your admission to a particular major depends on:

A. The weighted average score

B. The availability of seats in your chosen major. Students are assigned disciplines according to their grades - from the highest downwards - until all seats in each discipline are filled. This process is repeated with all students in all the options they have selected, with the aim of finding the best option that corresponds to each student's weighted average score.





If you are admitted into a major other than your first choice, it does not mean that you have completely missed the opportunity.

As soon as a seat becomes available in one of your top choices, due to a withdrawal, your major will be updated automatically, and this process continues until the start of the academic year.

If you reject the major you have been accepted in, you will not be offered that major or any other lower-preference major on your list of options. You will be placed on the waiting list and, depending on availability, you will be offered the higher-preference majors from your list of options.


If you do not respond with acceptance or rejection within the specified period, the acceptance will be considered void, and you will lose your chance permanently.



Note: If your preferred major is not available, we recommend you accept the proposed major so that you do not miss your opportunity to obtain admission to the university.

Initial Admission

After confirming your acceptance for the major to which you were admitted, only initial admission is granted until all required documents are uploaded within the specified time frame (refer to the documents list at the bottom of this page). Further instructions will be sent by email.



Final Admission

Once you meet all admission criteria and requirements, you will receive notification of unconditional admission, indicating that you are in the final stages of admission.



Enrollment

You will receive a student number, gain access to E-services, and be officially recognized as a university student.

Welcome Aboard!

• For Saudi students and Non-Saudi students of Saudi mothers:

- A copy of the original transcript of high school degrees and a
- certificate of studies completion.
 A current color photograph with a white background, ensuring that the student is not wearing glasses. Saudi traditional attire for male students and head covering with face uncovered for female
- students is required.
 A copy of the National ID for Saudis, or a copy of the student's Iqama and the National ID of the student's mother for non-Saudis of Saudi mothers, and a copy of the student's passport.

• For Non-Saudi students:

- A copy of the original transcript of high school
- degrees and a certificate of study completion.
 A current color photograph with a white background, ensuring that the student is wearing formal attire and no glasses.
- A copy of the student's passport, and a copy of the student's valid Iqama.


